## STORY ADD-ONS

Choose a picture book to “add to”—that is, one that has a repeating part or pattern. Figure out the pattern and then write and illustrate a whole new part to that story. For example, in *Pigs in the Mud in the Middle of the Rud* by Plourde & Schoenherr, animal after animal gets in the rud (road) and family member after family member tries to shoo the animals out of the rud. You could add-on to that story by adding a NEW animal to be shooed by a NEW family member (i.e. “Horses in the rud!” and Grandpa tries to shoo them).
