



HOW TO MAKE A MERRY MOOSEY PUPPET or ORNAMENT

1 Draw a moose head or face on one side of a small brown paper bag.

2 On a piece of colored construction paper, trace both your hands to make antlers.

3 Cut out your antlers. You may need help from an adult!



4 Glue your antlers on top of your moose head (bag).



5 Put your hand inside the bag to make a Moosey puppet!

To make a Moosey Ornament: 1. Punch a hole in the top of the paper bag. 2. Put a pipe cleaner through the hole and twist it on top to make a loop. (You can also use a ribbon instead of a pipe cleaner.) 3. Hang your MOOSEY ornament on your Christmas tree and . . .
